There was an occasion when Jesus met a blind man named Bartimaeus. Beyond the noise and opposition of the crowd, Bartimaeus got Jesus’ attention. Jesus asked Bartimaeus, “*What wilt thou that I should do unto thee?*” *Bartimaeus replied, “Lord, that I might receive my sight.”* Mark 10:51

First, if heaven asks what can be done for you, you must believe that God is able to do it. When you ask, you should expect to receive according to the Lord’s will. “*But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.*” James 1:5-7
