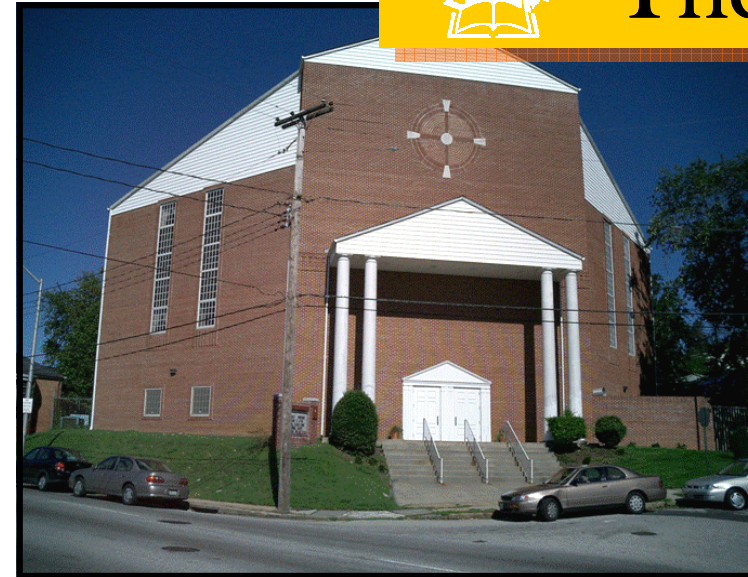

Good Works

Our Lord commands us to let our light shine, so others may see our good works and glorify our Father in heaven. The apostle Paul says, “*For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them*”. (Ephesians 2:10) In Titus 3:1 Paul instructs Titus to “*Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work.*” In his conclusion, Paul elaborates on the principle that good works are good and beneficial to humanity. “*This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.*” (Titus 3:8)
