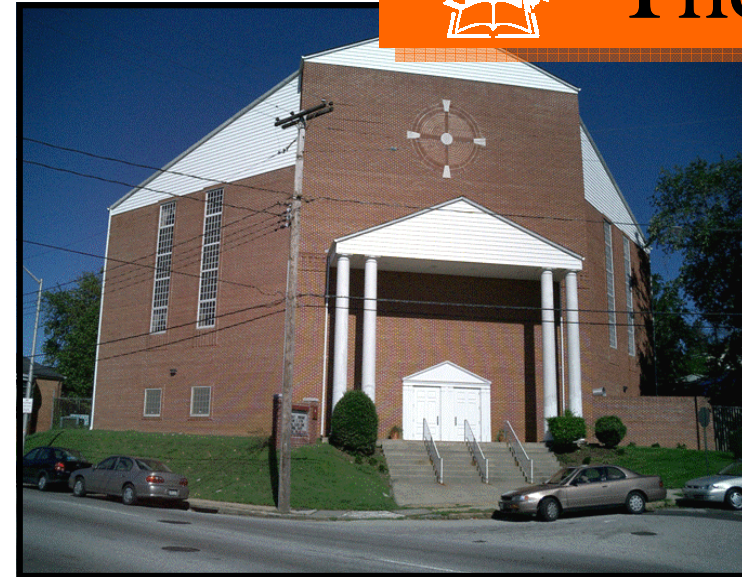

## From the Minister

### “God’s Security in a Shaky Economy” (Part 1)

Habakkuk, a prophet of God, faced issues that ultimately tested his faith. Habakkuk wanted to know how long God would allow violence and injustices. He asked the Lord, “O LORD, how long shall I cry, and thou wilt not hear! even cry out unto thee of violence, and thou wilt not save!” Habakkuk 1:2-4

We too have asked God the “how long” questions: How long must I suffer and the wicked go unpunished? How long must I wait for an answer or wait for a job? How long before I will marry or start a family? How long before salvation comes?

God revealed to Habakkuk His plan to use the Babylonians as His rod of judgment to correct His people. Because God’s plan seemed as wicked as Judah, Habakkuk then questioned God about His plan. “Thou art of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity: wherefore lookest thou upon them that deal treacherously, and holdest thy tongue when the wicked devoureth the man that is more righteous than he?” Habakkuk 1:13

Habakkuk learned that the just must live by faith and trust God. (Habakkuk 2:2-4) Since we do not have answers nor the details to our “how longs,” we do as the Heroes of Faith. We must learn to live by faith, trust God, and understand that “faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.” Hebrews 11:1
