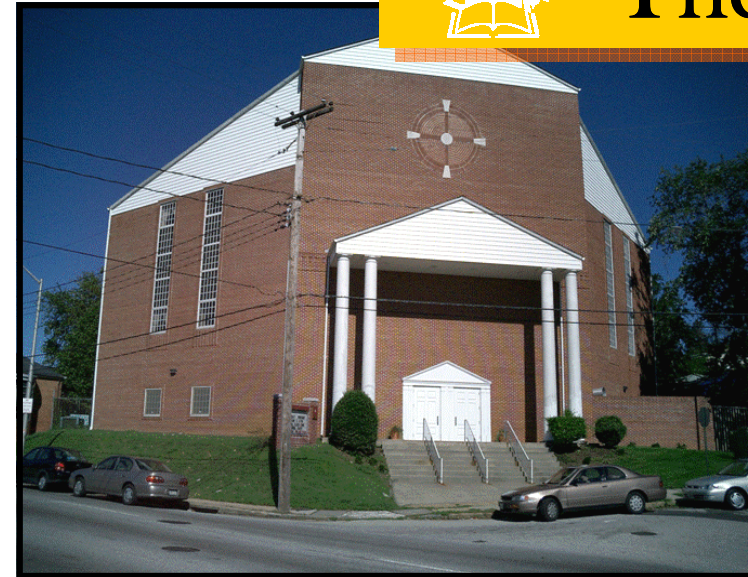

# From the Minister

What You Cannot Do With God  
(Part 2)

David desired to build a house for the Ark, after he built his palace. But the prophet Nathan informed David that God commanded him not to build a house, “because thou hast been a man of war, and hast shed blood.” God chose Solomon, David’s son, to build Him a house. “Solomon thy son, he shall build my house and my courts.” I Chronicles 28:1-6

God explained to David that the Ark of the Covenant (His Presence) had dwelt in a tent since the exodus from Egypt, through the period of Judges, and then up to the time of David’s desire to build a more permanent housing. But God wanted David to understand that HE is continuously and simultaneously present throughout the whole of creation. God is OMNIPRESENT. “Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool:” Isaiah 66:1

If anyone thinks God lives in a church building or they meet Him at church on Sundays, then their understanding of God is immature and their lives remain the same.
