The Greatest Detective

When investigating and revealing wrongdoings nothing compares to Sin, the greatest detective. Sin will find and reveal your deepest wrongdoings. Moses told the children of Reuben and Gad, "...*be sure your sins will find you out.*" **Numbers 32:1-23**
