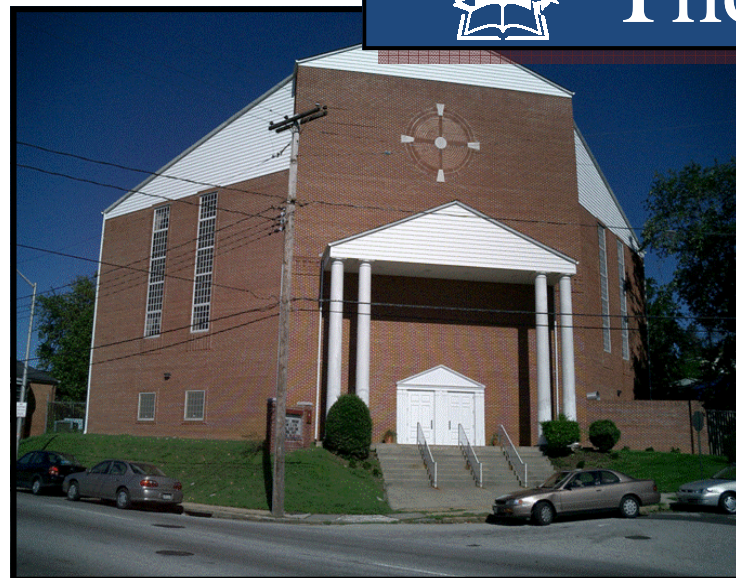

From the Minister

The Gospel that Paul Preached
(Part 1)

Paul preached the *Divine, Literal, Prophetic, Infallible, and Universal* gospel to the Corinthians when he said, “For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures.”

Paul, *who* unlike the 12 apostles, received the gospel by divine revelation. Jesus appeared to Paul as he traveled the road to Damascus. Jesus said unto Paul, “...open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.” Acts 26:18

Paul, in his letter to the Galatians also confirms, “... that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.” Galatians 1:11

Paul distinguishes the *death, burial* and *resurrection* of Jesus Christ as the gospel. He professes that he “neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.” Paul preached the divine gospel and according to Galatians, “there’s no other gospel”. If any man preaches anything different, then “let him be accursed.” He is preaching a humanistic and secular gospel that cannot save. Galatians 1:7-8
