The Gospel that Paul Preached  
(Part 2)

The gospel that Paul preached is a prophetic universal gospel. The word prophetic means *that which has been prophesied in the scripture.*

According to Isaiah 53, Jesus would be crucified and buried. In First Corinthians 15:3-4, Paul says, "For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures."

Isaiah 53:9 says "And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth." This was fulfilled when Joseph of Arimathaea, who was a rich man, came and begged for the body of Jesus and placed it in his new tomb. (Matthew: 27:57-60)

The scripture said Jesus would be resurrected on the third day (Psalm 16:10). In John 20, it says, "The first day of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre. For as yet they knew not the scripture, that he must rise again from the dead." John 20:1 and 9

Finally, the gospel that Paul preached was a Universal gospel. Jesus commanded the apostles to "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved ..." Mark 16:16

This is what Paul preached! If we believe it today, just as the Corinthians did 2000 years ago, we too will be saved.
