What You Can Not Do With God (Part1)

In a battle against the Philistines, Israel unexpectedly lost about four thousand men. It was at that time they decided to get the Ark of God from Shiloh, hoping it would save them when they returned to war with the Philistines. When the Philistines heard what they had done, they were afraid, but they were told to fight like men. During the battle, Israel lost thirty thousand men and the Ark of the Covenant was taken. After hearing of the death of his sons and that the Ark had been taken, the Chief Priest, Eli fell backward, broke his neck and died. (1 Samuel 4:1-11)

It was a terrible day in Israel because of the number of lives lost in battle. Most importantly, the Ark of the Covenant, which symbolized the presence of God, did not save them from their enemies.

Why do you think God allowed the Ark of the Covenant to be taken? Did Israel think God could be used for their convenience? How often do people try to use the Lord for their own gain, attempting to turn God on and off at their pleasure?

The Lord expects us to praise and worship Him at all times, not just at times when He is "needed". God wants us to understand that without Him, nothing is possible. "...thank we God without ceasing, ...which effectually worketh also in you that believe (1 Thessalonians 2:13).
